




Government was intended to Block Tyranny




Tension between Populism and Representation



5 Approaches to Engagement

#3 Proactive Approach

- Get to the core of conversations/challenges before they are issues.
- Ask your constituents what they stand for.
- Integrate your strategies with colleagues in public safety, education, business, etc?
- Don't compete for funding. Define the challenge and interconnectedness
- Ask people to sacrifice, this is a powerful concept in America.


